# Food pairing

Richly flavoured dishes, red meats and game. Beef, venison, goat, pheasant, chorizo. Red wine, pepper and reduction sauces.

# Vineyard

100% Estate grown shiraz handpicked from the rich loams of Siegersdorf vineyard in the heart of Barossa Valley.

Altitude 250-270m

#### Season

A warm, dry Spring and Summer season saw beautiful ripening in the Barossa. A wave of warm sunny days and cool nights saw good quality and generous fruit flavour development.

# Winemaking

Minimal intervention, destemmed and fermented on skins for 7 days with pump overs twice daily. Handcrafted in small parcels to exacting quality standards in our state of the art winemaking facility. Malolactic fermentation and maturation in barrel. Blended and lightly filtered before bottling.

# Maturation

Closure

15 months in new and seasoned French and American oak 300L barrels.
