OUR HOME IN THE BAROSSA VALLEY

The Barossa Valley is Australia's pre-eminent wine region, internationally acclaimed and respected for producing world class Shiraz, Grenache and Rhône blends.

Hare's Chase is located at Marananga, approximately 4 kilometres to the west of Tanunda in the Barossa Valley. The winery is surrounded by a 17-hectare (42 acre) estate, planted to Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon, Grenache, Mataro (also known as Mourvèdre) and Viognier.

The estate is comprised of 12 separate blocks that vary in topography and soil profiles. The surrounding hillsides are peppered with quartzite and ironstone deposits; a block of ironstone from the vineyard welcomes visitors to the front gate of the winery.







OUR SENIOR WINEMAKER

With 20 years of winemaking experience Matt Reynolds brings exceptional skill and a deep understanding of the diverse Barossa landscape to the task of crafting the Hare's Chase wines. His approach reflects a desire to promote a symbiotic connection between vineyard, winemaker and winery. He respects the innate characteristics of the region and the site, with winemaking inputs serving only to showcase their distinctive strengths through each wine.

Matt works alongside fellow winemaker Max Gu, forming a collaborative team with a shared vision.

"The landscape of the Hare's Chase estate at Marananga resembles a patchwork quilt of several soil types that varies as you traverse across subtle changes in aspect and elevation. Taking advantage of this diversity and the subtle character nuances in the fruit we grow here allows me to build greater complexity in wines that we aim to be an exemplary reflection of the special nature of this place."





WINES OF HARE'S CHASE

IRONSCRAPER SHIRAZ

Rich and full, vibrant and fresh. Red cherry, raspberry and plum; whole black pepper, spice, cinnamon and chocolate notes; soft acidity velvety, chewy tannins, length and persistence.

VIGILANCE MARANANGA SHIRAZ

Handpicked and basket pressed. Concentrated red and black fruits, whole black pepper, tarry, savoury characters; rich and ripe layered black savoury fruits, supple fine tannins.



MARANANGA CABERNET SHIRAZ

Classic blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Shiraz, paying homage to the great Australian red.

Concentrated core of raspberry, black cherry and plum.

Framework and structure from the Cabernet Sauvignon; fruit generosity and mid-palate richness from the Shiraz.

THE SPRINGER SHIRAZ

Fresh, bright red fruits. Wild strawberry, raspberry, cherry and plum; balanced acidity, dusty ripe tannins providing body and texture.
