

MOUNT LANGI GHIRAN

2019 Cliff Edge Riesling

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The 2019 Cliff Edge Riesling is sourced from two premium sites at Mount Langi Ghiran: the Langi Old Block Riesling planted in 1975 and the Hollows vineyard planted in 2004 – a marginally warmer site on the northern slopes of Mount Langi Ghiran.

Langi's cool climate, together with granite sands and minimal irrigation delivers great purity and stunning natural acidity. The Hollows fruit brings beautifully lifted floral and spice aromas with wonderful texture and generosity to the palate. The two combine to create an intense and balanced Riesling with great cellaring potential.

TASTING NOTE

Colour: Pale straw.

Nose: White flowers and spices, layered with citrus, stone fruits and lime pith.

Palate: Stone fruits, dried citrus peel and spices. A naturally high acidity provides length, texture and persistence of flavour.

Cellar: A great wine to drink now or to cellar for a further 10 years.

Region: Grampians

Vineyard: Mount Langi Ghiran

Vine age: 44 years

Soil: Granite sand over red clay

Harvest date: Early March 2019

Harvest method: Hand harvested

WINEMAKING NOTE

Fermentation method: This fruit was hand harvest and pressed to stainless steel tank where it saw a slow, cool fermentation to retain aromatics, flavour and freshness.
