First planted by Maurice O'Shea in 1946, the Rosehill vineyard is a wonderful site. Producing wines that are quintessentially Hunter Valley, they are bright, red fruited and elegant, with the ability to age gracefully for the long term. Tasting Notes

Red berries, violets, and spice on the nose with a beautiful supple and elegant tannin profile, completed with excellent length.

Fresh and lovely as a young wine, the Rosehill Shiraz will reward those with patience, maturing in bottle for at least 25 years.
