2021 Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon

Parker Estate Cabernet represents truly exceptional value. Made with flavour and generosity in mind, the goal is always to create bright and vibrant wines to please any drinker.

Viticulture

Fruit for our Estate Cabernet Sauvignon is sourced from several exceptional parcels throughout Coonawarra. The majority comes from our Abbey estate and viticulturist Brett Williams' own vineyards. The cool climate of the region, plentiful water supply and a temperate growing season ensure impeccable quality of fruit with superb flavour and ripeness.

Winemaking

The grapes are picked using a Pellenc Select Harvester which picks and de-stems in the vineyard to deliver pristine berries to the winery, a winemakers dream. 10t open fermenters are used for oxidation, stability and colour and tannin extraction and the blend is allowed to ferment on skins for an average of 10 days. Following fermentation, all of the parcels completed malolactic fermentation in stainless steel. The wine is then transferred into old French oak Barriques and Hogsheads for 12 months on average prior to bottling.

Tasting Notes

Colour: Deep ruby red core with purple hues.

Aroma: Rich aromas of dark fruits, blueberry and blackcurrant. Soft hints of vanilla, mixed with warming spices and undertones of dark chocolate.

Palate: A medium bodied palate with dark fruits such as cherry and blackberry at the core. A slight earthiness and toasty hints balanced with soft, fine tannins.
