Tasting Note

Made from estate grown Pinot Noir, this gorgeously crisp Rosé sits pretty in the glass with a pale salmon hue. On the nose you will find the classic Pinot characteristics of strawberries and cream, while the palate remains savoury with a mouth watering crisp and dry finish.

Ticking all the boxes for a delicate but flavor packed cool climate Rosé, this Adelaide Hills drop has Friday night drinks written all over it. Ice it down, drink it up and exhale!
