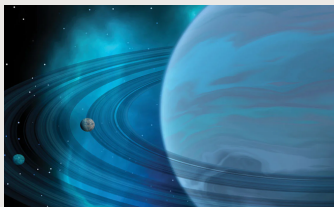
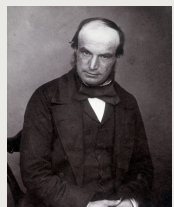

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Traditional Barossa Classics

Eden Valley and Barossa Valley sub regions make up the Barossa where uniquely both cool and warm climates exist in the same region. The influence of structure and finesse from Eden Valley, with the power and richness of Barossa Valley results in wines to delight upon release and cellaring capabilities for the coming decades.

Finely grained French oak barrels weathered prior to coopering, support the natural fruit and tannins without being overbearing. The investment in quality oak, time for maturing in barrel and bottle, is evident in the commitment to quality under all Sorby Adams wines.

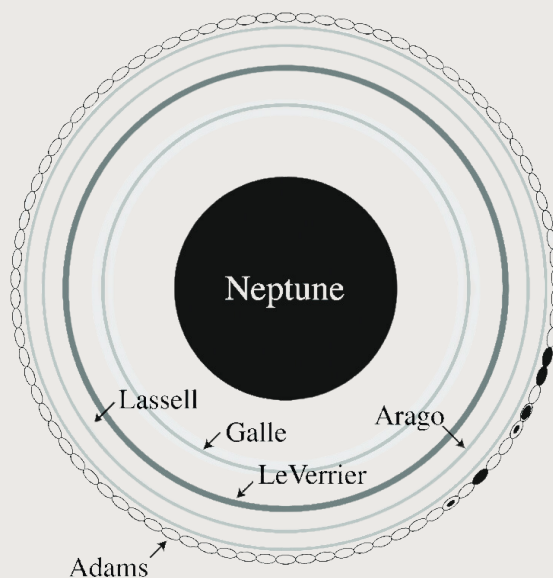

Traditional Barossa Classics made from the varieties of Shiraz, Cabernet, Grenache and Mourvedre.

Blending Eden Valley refinement with Barossa Valley power, these wines are quintessential Barossa. Our reds are aged in finely grained French oak barrels for 24 months. The Barossa reds are rich and serious drinking upon release of for up to 10 years.
