



Driven by the complexity of each grape variety, "Debut" wines are best enjoyed upon release, although reds can be cellared for up to four years.

Each of the Regional Series wines are grown where the optimal expression of its variety can be achieved. Site and varietal selection is the result of more than thirty years of research, trial and observation of vine performance in Capel Vale's various vineyards.

These elegant and graceful wines display refined fruit character and a degree of ageing appropriate to the variety. Perfectly approachable upon release, they will however, reveal their strength and pedigree with further appropriate cellaring.

The Single Vineyard wines represent the ultimate expression of varietal fruit flavour and winemaking excellence from Capel Vale. They are only released in years when the highest quality standards are achieved.

Winemakers are constantly alert to the subtle nuances that characterize a truly exceptional vintage within a specific viticultural region. When such an opportunity presents itself, a single vineyard release is possible.

These wines are an exceptional statement of hand-crafted winemaking, displaying great character, concentration, harmony and balance.
