Winemaker's Notes

Bright ruby purple in colour. Warm, enticing blueberry aromas with mocha chocolate, cedar spice, plums and cassis. Big, soft and generous, the palate displays plum and berry compote, toasted vanilla and boysenberry. Hints of mocha chocolate complement the rich, velvety finish.

Enjoy with homemade saltbush lamb sausage rolls, or cherry tomato and tapenade tartlets.

Vintage Information

A long, cold and slightly drier Barossa winter that warmed to a mild spring, allowed the vines to produce a lighter crop and good canopies. Typical summer warmth and minimal rainfall allowed the grapes to ripen, and resulted in spectacular wines of rich and robust flavour.
