Sevenhill is one of the oldest wineries in Australia and viewed as a national treasure.

This extraordinary heritage is reflected in the wine, the site itself and its link to the birth of a nation, which is something precious to be celebrated.

A site of historical significance, Sevenhill Cellars is the original Clare Valley winery.

Its 90 hectares of vines, provide premium fruit for a diverse range of estate-grown and handcrafted wines including Riesling, Pinot Gris, Barbera, Grenache, Touriga, Merlot, Shiraz and Cabernet Sauvignon.

Our vines are part of what make Sevenhill unique, and this is where our heritage clones come into play. Our heritage Shiraz vines were planted in 1860, Grenache was planted in 1920 and 1966, and Cabernet 1975.

It is not just the vines which make Sevenhill special. The mesoclimate and soils these vines are grown in, also contribute to the layers of flavour and intrigue.

A Gourmet Traveller-awarded cellar door, it is a picturesque property centered on a tree-lined Village Green and home to the landmark St Aloysius Church.

PINOT GRIS

A nose of spiced pears with hints of apple blossom and musk accompany the soft acidity and distinct mid-palate sweetness.



FIELD BLEND-OFF DRY

A complex wine of soft acidity and juicy sweetness, this 'Grown-up's Moscato' has a rose petal aroma with hints of pear and musk.

A wine of ample body and depth of flavours with bright red-berry fruits complimented by hints of chocolate with lingering, soft tannins.



BARBERA

Aromas of plum with a touch of earthiness with sweet, juicy fruits on the palate, balanced by soft tannings and gentle acidity.



CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Great depth of flavours from intense, dark fruit with aromas of blackberry, juniper berry and subtle hints of salt-bush.

The distance the Jesuits travelled on foot, at night, from Sevenhill to the township of Burra so they could sell butter and produce to the miners. The proceeds were used to improve the Sevenhill estate.

Aromas of lemon and orange blossom, with hints of jasmine and a clean finish.



SPIRE'S LAMENT VIOGNIER

RRP • \$45

The Jesuits always wanted the St Aloysius Church located on the property to have a spire. The funds were always used for more pressing community projects. This is a dream which has not been fulfilled.

Apricot and rockmelon aromas, with marzipan and toasted granola.

OPEN RANGE GRENACHE

RRP • \$80

This was the original name of the property before the Jesuits renamed the land they purchased. Sevenhill, after the seven hills of Rome.

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Baked eggplant and green olive aromas, with spice, a hint of oak, and silky tannins.



QUARRY ROAD CABERNET MALBEC

RRP • \$50

Stone was quarried from two sites on the estate, to build the winery, College, and St Aloysius church. These two grape varieties capture the essence of how Cabernet and Malbec work so well together.

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Blackcurrant and hints of capsicum and umami. Fine and grippy tannins.



THATCH AND CLAY TOURIGA

RRP • \$50

The humble original housing on the property in the early years, made of thatch and clay.

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Lifted and perfumed aromas of rose petal and confection. A vibrant cherry palate.
