
Barossa is arguably the single most famous wine region in Australia. Barossa includes both Barossa Valley and Eden Valley, making it one of the only areas in Australia to have neighbouring warm and cool climate growing conditions. This makes it ideal to grow both white varieties like Riesling and red varieties like Shiraz.

Heirloom Eden Valley Riesling, Heirloom Barossa Shiraz and Heirloom A'Lambra Barossa Shiraz.




McLaren Vale Located between the ocean and the hills, McLaren Vale is renowned for premium production and sustainable winegrowing. With a Mediterranean climate, the region is best known for Shiraz, yet McLaren Vale also excels in the production of ultra-premium Grenache and alternative varieties.


The Adelaide Hills is bordered to the North by the Barossa and Eden Valley and McLaren Vale to the South, but due to its altitude, the Adelaide Hills is significantly cooler and wetter, making it ideal for growing white varieties like Sauvignon Blanc and Chardonnay and reds like Pinot Noir.
