Variety: Red Blend (Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Ruby Cabernet, Merlot) Appellation: McIaren Vale, Langhorne Ceeek, Riverland Soil: Red / Black Loam - Sandy Red / Black Loams

PRODUCTION

Harvest: Non vintage blend predominanty March 2020 Forment: French & American hogshead barrel, tank Maturation: 9 to 12 months

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TASTE

Color: Crimson red with purple hues.

Nose: Lifted red fruts of cranberry, sour cherry, raspberry and redcurrant mingle with floral notes of violets and rose petal.

Palate: Cherry, red plum and boysenberry provide a juicy mid palate with touches of vanilla bean, cinnamon and nutmeg providing complexity. The fine line of natural acidity and plush tannins provide focus and a softness through the finish.
