Vintage Notes

"The Yarra Valley has been lucky and although the best-laid plans were turned on their heads we had a great vintage. Much to our surprise vintage was two weeks late and we experienced incredibly cool ripening conditions punctuated by rainfall events that slowed picking on many vineyard sites. It was an eight-week vintage with crop levels across all varietals down 30-40% and acidity much higher than the previous several years in the Yarra. This made picking at optimum times difficult and resulted in our grape-growers being significantly down on their budgeted yields. The standout wines are Chardonnay and Pinot Gris, closely followed by Pinot Noir from the cooler sites around Gladysdale and Yarra Junction".- Rob Dolan
