### Lindsay Wine Estate

Lindsay Wine Estate is the creation of Will Bolton and Matt Dunning, two friends who share a love for music, art and wine. Will and Matt have combined these passions into Lindsay Wine Estate – a new, modern, yet rustic cellar door boasting private tasting and entertainment areas, art and a vinyl collection of over 4,000 records. It's the perfect place to relax while listening to some of your favourite artists with a glass of fine wine in hand.

### Proud Heritage

Named in honour of the Australian artist Sir Lionel Lindsay, Lindsay Wine Estate is a new brand proudly paying homage to a strong, bold heritage. Lindsays works featured the early Australian pioneers who explored and worked the land. In the 1940s he formed a friendship with William (Bill) Bolton MBE, a man drawn to Lindsay's artistic vision of early Australia, and he became an avid collector of Lindsay's work. Prior to his death in 1973, Bolton's collection of more than 400 artworks and 3,000 books, maps and manuscripts was donated, to become The Lionel Lindsay Collection. Today, in the Barossa Valley, Bill Bolton's grandson Will and his business partner Matt Dunning are continuing this interest in Lindsay's work. Drawing upon the pioneering spirit captured in Lindsay's paintings, Will and Matt have created a premium range of estate-grown wines and a unique cellar door experience.

South Australia Range

The Riverland in South Australia is a long-established, warm climate wine producing region, located east of the Barossa Valley. It extends for 330 km along the Murray River from Paringa to Blanchetown.

It is spoiled with abundant sunshine, a consistent ripening period and a reputation for full bodied wines that display intense colour along with vibrant fruit flavours. Home to many of Australia's largest brands, we source a high proportion of our grapes from this great region.

These wine styles have been produced to enjoy young as fresh fruit driven wines.



Regional Range

Our regional range has been sourced from our favorite regions across South Australia which we feel deliver the true varietal characters of these traditional styles. Eden Valley for its higher altitude and cooler climate while the Clare Valley are perfect for Riesling. The Barossa Valley has of course dominated this range with its diversity for red wines.

Fruit driven whites and reds with a little oak influence, this range really brings out the regional and varietal tones. Fresh in their youth these wines have been made with drinking in mind and can be enjoyed now or cellared for a few more years to enjoy the complexities of slightly older styles.

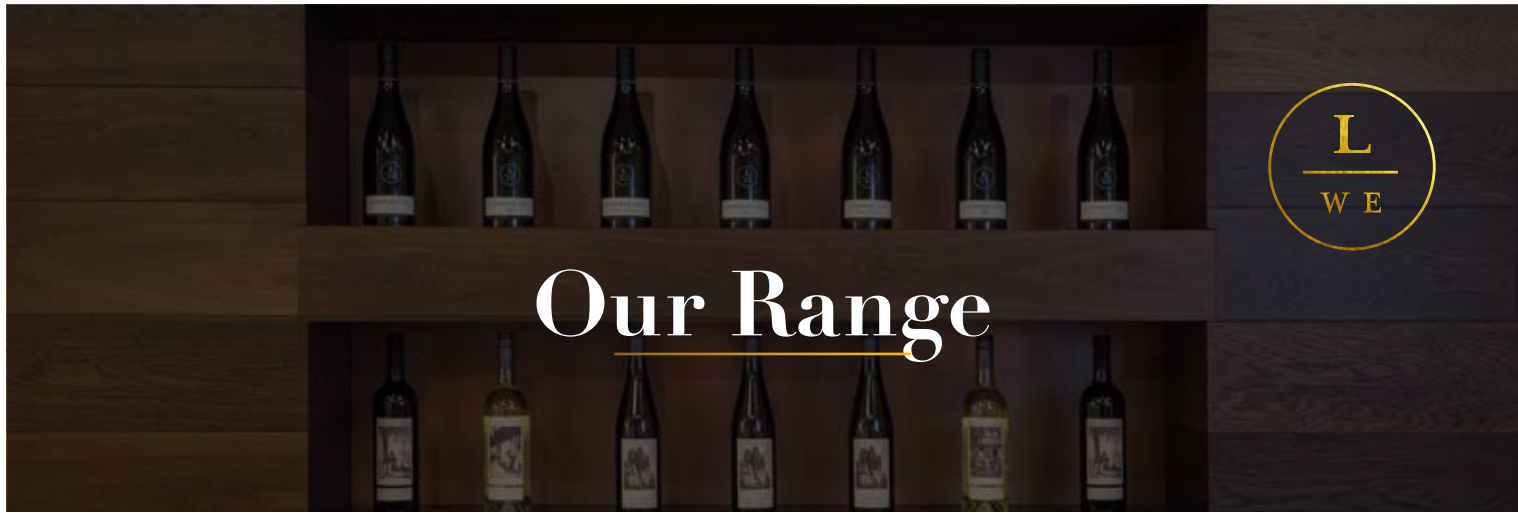

### Estate Grown

The Barossa Valley is arguably Australia's most famous wine region. Classified as warm climate, the Barossa provides excellent conditions for full-bodied wines with Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon and Grenache dominating the red plantings.

### Barossa Valley Range

The Barossa is home to a Mediterranean climate. It is dry with low humidity, a relatively low rainfall, and it receives a bucketload of sunshine; this equals an ideal climate for full-bodied reds and robust white wines. And contrary to what you might think, the Barossa only has slightly warmer climates than Margaret River and Bordeaux.

When it comes to soil type, the Barossa has a complex system of transverse sub-valleys and twisting hills across different elevations, slopes and sites. That means the soils vary widely, ranging from clay loam to sandy soil, and grey to red and brown.

Our Estate range of wines are fuller styles, aged in barrel and the bottled however are still released with cellaring in mind. These wines are true reflections of a combination of both Matt and Will's preferred styles.

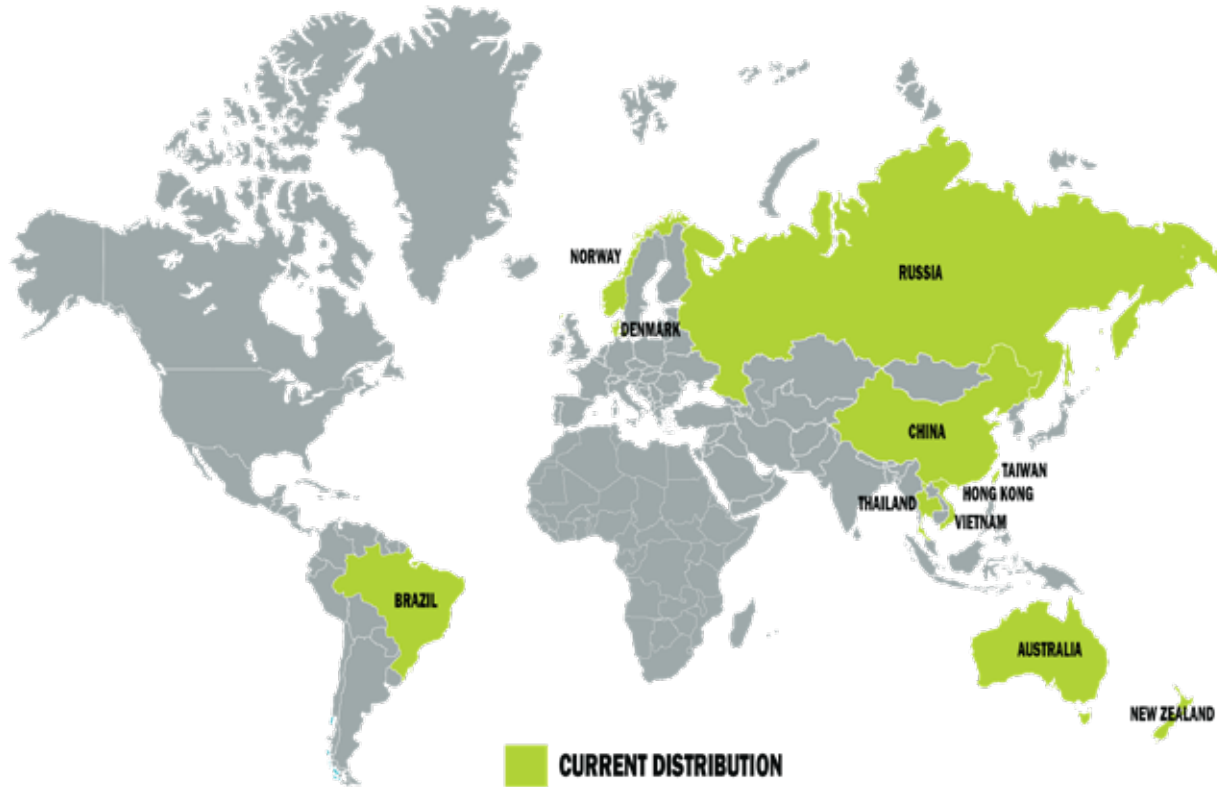
