HUGO Cabernet Sauvignon 2018

The Hugo Cabernet Sauvignon is planted right at the top of the estate against the McLaren Vale foothills. Due to this unique location conditions are markedly cooler due to the elevation and gully breezes. This results in a longer ripening period and more elegant Cabernet with generous mouth feel and fine soft tannins.

Tasting Note Medium bodied, black fruits of blackcurrant, black cherry accompanied by a hint of chocolate, violet and sage. Balanced Cabernet fruit, with a rich middle palate and fine soft tannins.

Vintage The 2018 Vintage was a very strong season in McLaren Vale with no extreme weather events and average yields.

Vineyard Estate grown Hugo Cabernet Sauvignon planted by John and Liz Hugo on the elevated Hugo Estate. Single cordon with fixed foliage/catch wires

Winemaking Fermented on skins for 7 days with gentle pump-overs twice per day. Maturation in predominately French oak hogsheads & larger format French oak puncheons for 16 months. 15% New oak.

Serve Fillet Beef, roast Beetroot & Carrot with Caraway seed.
