



SKILLOGALEE

TREVARRICK SHIRAZ

“Trevarrick Farm” was the original name of our property when it was first settled by John and Anne Trestrail in the 1850s. More than a century later in 1970, vines were planted on this magnificent land and the Skillogalee vineyards were established. When we harvest the grapes, each individual contour block on the estate picked and handled individually, the Trevarrick name is reserved for those contours which exhibit exceptional quality and varietal character of the vintage and showcase the essence of Skillogalee.

The Trevarrick Shiraz is produced from these single contour vineyards on the high-elevation hillside slopes of the Skillogalee Estate in the Clare Valley. This unique and undulating land, with its varied combination of soil, topography, viticulture, sunlight and temperature, results in a diverse selection of premium quality grapes from which we create our wines.

VINTAGE

With cool and dry weather, the 2021 vintage in the Clare Valley produced lovely fruit with excellent varietal character and natural acidity. The cool growing season was preceded by late-winter and early-spring rains which allowed for good spring growth on the vines. This was followed by below average rainfall and dry conditions for the remainder of the season, resulting in a vintage that produced beautiful and classic Clare wines with smaller bunches and grapes therefore reducing yield.

APPEARANCE

The wine has a luxurious, rich, crimson colour.

NOSE

A complex and layered nose that showcases the terroir and winemaking with notes of dark fruit (blackberry, black cherry), spices (black pepper, cloves) and a subtle floral or herbaceous character.

PALATE

The palate shows lifted berry fruit flavours of mulberry and dark fruit spice with a concentrated rich fruit core and long mouth-coating tannin.

WHEN TO DRINK

The wine is crafted in a way that it can be enjoyed thoroughly upon release, but has the tannin and acid structure to mature gracefully for ten+ years.

FOOD PAIRING

Enjoy with bold flavours and rich textures of grilled or roasted red meats, barbecue, spicy cuisine styles from Mexico, Indian or Asia, along with hearty stews and slow cooked dishes.
