One of 13 ships fatefully claimed by the jagged rocks and treacherous seas making this one of South Australia's most feared coastlines. Carpenter Rocks wines reveal the essence of the Limestone Coast - Mount Gambier's cool climate. All hands-on processes, all heart.

The Altschwager family has farmed these soils filled with limestone and flint for 150 years - the same rock that wrecked the Admella.
