# Vintage:

The 2018 vintage is an outstanding vintage in the Barossa, with good winter rains and a mild growing season allowing full flavour development of the berries.

#### Tasting notes:

This wine is a minor variation on the traditional GSM (Grenache Shiraz Mataro) with the Mataro replaced by Roussanne. With the Rousanne adding a freshness and lift to the nose and palate. The Barossa has the ideal soils and climates for producing full flavoured "Rhone Blends". The nose on this wine is lovely lifted and fragrant with berry fruits and fresh herbs. The palate is very bright and vibrant with Raspberry fruit, a touch of confection, fresh mint and some earthy notes. It is of medium weight with the sweet fruit lingering through the palate and balanced with fine grained tannins. The wine finishes with a flourish with great flavor and intensity. It is drinking well now or will repay careful cellaring for up to ten years.
