These elegant, vibrant wines are made with Adelaide Hills fruit – they are perfectly suited for every occasion.

Tasting Note

This Pinot has lifted aromas of cherry and toasted spice, with bright berry flavours and a hint of earthiness on the palate. Soft tannins and a savoury finish complete the story of this young and vibrant wine.
