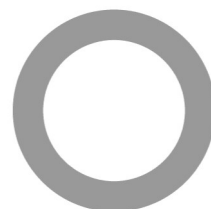

#### *Description*

Cassegrain's winemaking heritage began in France in 1643. A heritage of French winemaking skills that today combines with Australian technology to produce wines that are full flavoured, yet soft and elegant in their structure.

The 2017 Falerne is made from the classic varieties of Merlot, Petit Verdot and Cabernet Sauvignon. Full bodied with blackcurrant and blueberry aromas. A complex mocha and French oak flavor with integrated tannins and a long finish.
