

A boutique winery, Munari Wines sits in the heart of the Heathcote wine region, nestled at the base of Mount Ida among gum trees and the quaint, 'Ladys Creek'. Established in 1992, by ex-school teachers, Adrian and Deborah Munari, whose passion for winemaking and lengthy experience has established Munari Wines' exceptional reputation. Now lovingly managed by daughter, India Munari, the business is looking toward the future.

Producing between 2000-3000 cases annually, all red wines are grown, produced and bottled on site.


OWNER, VITICULTURALIST & WINEMAKER

Since completing his Associate Diploma of Applied Science (Viticulture), buying the 57 acre property and retiring from the teaching industry, Adrian Munari has built a reputation for fruit driven, elegant and structured wines.

With a passion for exploring wine style and experimenting with new varieties, over his thirty years, Adrian has had plenty of experience with traditional varieties and as well as alternative varieties such as Sangiovese, Verdelho, Vermentino, Malbec & Petit Verdot.

A recent career highlight was winning the wine of the show at the 2021 Heathcote Wine Show with a white wine, the first time it had happened in the history of the show and in only the second year of producing wine with Garganega.

"We want to offer easy drinking wines of great value to those who have no tasting experience and to those who are seasoned veterans", Adrian Munari.



OUR REGION



Heathcote is located 90 minutes of Melbourne in Central Victoria and comprised of a 80km long strip of red soil situated on 550,000 million year old Cambrian bedrock. The region's southern vineyards experience cooler temperatures, greater rainfall and generally do not have access to additional water supplies while the north is drier and typically receives an average of 5-10mm less rain per month during the growing season but growers have access to a pipeline from nearby Lake Cooper. Munari Wines is located in the center of the region nestled between the base of Mt Ida and the Mt Camel, these ranges act as a rain shadow and as such, Ladys Pass is one of the drier areas of the region. Munari Wines is located 200 meters above sea level and receives 280mm of annual rain fall, the vineyard relies wholly on the rainwater captured in dams which the vineyards are irrigated from.










Medium to full bodied, elegant and fruit driven reds designed to be enjoyed with food

Named after Adrian's fathers region in Italy. This is a traditional grape produced from the region. The 2021 vintage was a triple trophy winner with a subtle richness to it



LATE HARVEST VIOGNIER


Harvested late in the season when the fruit is perfectly ripe and starting to dehydrate, this wine tastes of apricots and candied citrus peel with a clean, fresh finish
