Food pairing

Vineyard

100% Estate grown riesling from Eden Springs Vineyard. Beautiful cool climate country at High Eden, the pinnacle of Barossa. Altitude 460-515m

Season

A warm, dry Spring and Summer season saw beautiful ripening in High Eden. A wave of warm sunny days and cool nights saw good quality and generous fruit flavour development. Riesling shows excellent aromatic perfume, depth and gentle acid balance.

Winemaking

Handpicked, crushed and destemmed, cool fermentation in stainless steel to preserve primary fruit and perfume. Bottled while young and fresh. Handcrafted to exacting quality standards in our state of the art winemaking facility.
