Corymbia is a wine born from over 110 years of Western Australian grape growing and winemaking experience. The wines are made by Rob and Genevieve Mann from vineyards they farm from dirt to bottle in the Swan Valley & Margaret River regions of Western Australia.

Corymbia wines are organically farmed, single vineyard wines offering the purest expression of fruit and a clear sense of place. The fruit is dry grown, organically farmed from mature vines planted from the mid 80's. Winemaking is very traditional using techniques such as hand harvesting, gravity, oak fermentation, indigenous yeast and natural malolactic fermentation. Where oak is used, it is seasoned oak subtly offering support to the fruit. The wines express the qualities of the Swan Valley & Margaret River that Rob's family has admired from the region for over 100 years.

Corymbia Rocket's Vineyard Chenin Blanc 2022

The wine smells of jasmine blossom, ruby grapefruit and freshly picked red Johnathon apples straight from the tree. Packham pears, Kumamoto oysters and beeswax fill the palate but it's the texture that grabs your full attention. The balance at play between the juicy, saline tang and the soft, creamy, flinty notes drives home the Rocket's Vineyard pedigree. Classic Rocket's Vineyard Chenin Blanc at its best.

Corymbia Calgardup Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon 2023

The mild dry season was close to perfect, and we could not be more excited about this release. The wines from this vintage have a clarity, freshness and density which bodes well for showing well early, but these will be long lived wines having a wonderful tannin spine and lively acidity.

Pomegranate, crème de cassis, violets and rolled tobacco combine for a fragrant and lifted aroma. The wine tastes of the grape, the dirt and the sea with bright black fruits and Dutch licorice complemented by wet slate and nori notes. Medium bodied but packed with personality it has incredible length. It's worth decanting and pulling out your best glasses despite having to then wash and dry them by hand.
