Vintage:

Good winter rains leading up to the 2017 growing season, combined with a cooler than average spring and early summer meant the vines grew slowly but healthily. The trick in 2017 was to let the grapes hang longer to accumulate a greater amount of colour and flavour.

Tasting notes:

The 2017 Wilsford Shiraz is a typical rich and fruit driven style of Barossa Shiraz with a deep red colour. The palate is medium to full bodied displaying rich berry fruit, raspberry coolie and creamy chocolate oak. The cooler vintage shows with spiciness and a hint of peppercorn. There is a beautiful creamy texture on the palate with velvety tannins. The wine is starting show some secondary characters with roasted meats and savouriness that will increase as the wine ages. It finishes with great length.
