


SISTER'S RUN

About Us:

Sister's Run is serious fun. Our talented young winemaker Elena wears steel cap work boots every day of course, but carries a pair of high heels in back of the ute, only for emergencies, like last minute invitations to accept trophies at gala wine show dinners and the like.

Returning from a 'knees-up' at midnight, mid vintage, she managed to kick off one high heel and slip back into a boot' just as the cellar crew cried out, 'Run Sister Run'; and exactly then our winemaker and label took flight!

The stiletto and boot are Sister's Run; an independently owned and operated winery with a fierce commitment to making the best wines we can from family vineyards. We don't take ourselves as seriously as we take our wines, but agree with Elena, all you need to know about wine is the five 'V's and remember the best wine is the wine you like.

Colour:

Dark purple, crimson and cheerful - almost winking at the brim...

Nose:

Classic yet refined Barossa shiraz aromatics: dark liqueur chocolate - but hand-made by an imaginary 8th generation chocolatier. Dark plums that are ripe but also savoury and dusted by the Autumn's drying earth. Floating over the top a perfume of gentle oak spice; then comes soy and green herb and truffle undertones; anise and cola nut, black peppercorns and sarsaparilla.

Entry:

Flooding and generous fruits yet fruits fresh and alive.

Middle Palate:

Adding deeper textural layers comes reduced blackberry and raspberry, prunes rehydrated by freshly fallen rain water, dates carrying Ra's blessing. Balanced.

Finish:

Balanced. The soft, pillowy tannins soften the strict acidity which - in its turn - keeps the fruit's expressions more under than overstated

In Summary:

Power without any headiness; a glassful of red wine without any lacking; modern Barossa. The best elements of Barossan shiraz spun through an Elfin loom. Imperceptibly choreographed as it barely steps across your palate, yet the footprints remain. As close to 'being there' as the grape on the vine.
