



Parking and precinct operations

Precinct traffic management

Since the last meeting, we have implemented:

- Geo Fencing for Ride Share Vehicles now in place for events with 20,000+ attendees. This:
 - •Creates controlled pick-up areas
 - Improves traffic flows; and
 - Reduces crossover areas for pedestrians and vehicles.
- Traffic Controllers on Moore Park Road deployed to actively manage taxi movements and pedestrian crossings, keeping traffic moving and minimise post-event congestion.
- Two Point-to-Point Commissioners on Site one patrolling, one enforcing, ensuring taxis do not linger and block critical access areas. TfNSW are on call to redeploy resources if additional coverage is required.
- Additional Transport Commanders on Site providing oversight and intervening early to clear congestion before it escalates.
- Share Bike Management a dedicated manager now attends events to remove and reposition bikes, ensuring footpaths remain clear and safe for pedestrian use.



Timeline of parking restrictions on Moore Park East


Lower Kippax (yellow), located opposite the multilevel carpark development, will be closed to parking from the later of 1 July 2026 or a date prescribed by regulation if the carpark development isn't complete.

Showground Field (red), located opposite the Hordern Pavilion, closed to parking from the later of 1 July 2028 or a date prescribed by regulation if there is no alternative transport and/or parking arrangements to service the precinct.

Wording from the act is as follows:

20AA Restrictions on parking in Moore Park East

- (1) The following areas of the Trust lands are closed to parking of vehicles—
- (a) the non-parking areas,
- (b) carpark 2, Lower Kipp ax—from the later of the following—
- (i) 1 July 2026,
- (ii) a date prescribed by regulation,
- (c) non-parking grass areas that are not referred to in paragraph (b)—from the later of the following—
- (i) 1 July 2028,
- (ii) a date prescribed by regulation.
- (1A) The Minister may recommend the making of a regulation under subsection (1)(b)(ii) or (c)(ii) only if—
- (a) for subsection (1)(b)(ii)—a new car park on Venues NSW's land adjacent to the Sydney Football Stadium is not built and opento the public and operational, and
- (b) for subsection (1)(c)(ii)—the Minister is satisfied there is no appropriate plan to address transport needs, including parking, in relation to events at the Sydney Cricket Ground and Sydney Football Stadium.
- (1B) Also, if a regulation is made under subsection (1)(c)(ii), the Minister must—
- (a) within 1 month after the making of the regulation, give a report to the Presiding Officer of each House of Parliament about why the Minister recommended the making of the regulation, and
- (b) while the regulation remains in force, give a report to the Presiding Officer of each House of Parliament at least once in each 12 month period about why the Minister considers the regulation remains necessary.
- (1C) A report provided to the Presiding Officer of a House of Parliament under subsection (1B) must be laid before that House within 5 sitting days of that House after it is received by the Presiding Officer.
