Stormwater and wastewater

Class-based lesson

Your students will learn about :

- The difference between stormwater and wastewater
- What happens when the wrong things go down the drain
- What they can do at home and school to improve their local environment

This lesson is a hands-on, collaborative outdoor activity where your students create a terrain with lakes and rivers, to consolidate what they learn in class about the journey water makes from lakes, down rivers and smaller waterways to the sea.
