ALERT TONE (Beep, Beep, Beep)	If you hear this tone: • follow your Wardens' directions, they know the safest exit route
EVACUATION TONE (Whoop, Whoop, Whoop)	If you hear this tone: • leave via the nearest safe emergency exit • go to the nominated evacuation assembly point • wait there until advised that you can return to the building
CRIMINAL ACTS	If you see a criminal act: • dial 000 and ask for the police, then advise the Airport Co-ordination Centre on 9297 1601

MEDICAL EMERGENCIES	To summon help for medical emergencies • call the Airport Co-ordination Centre on 9297 1601 • provide basic details (eg. age, sex, nature of problem
TELEPHONE THREATS (Bomb, Extortion, Other)	If you receive a threatening call: 1. don't hang up (even if they hang up) so that the line will remain open for tracing 2. ask questions (who, what, where, when) 3. record the details (time, specific threat, information about the caller, background noises) 4. on another phone, notify the police on 9247 3222, advise them of the threat and the need for a call trace 5. call Melbourne Airport Coordination Centre on 9297 1601 6. wait for further advice
