Company Registration Process

All companies (Primary Contractors & Sub-Contractors) are to be registered before any applications can be processed online. Registration forms are available on our website: **www.melbourneairport.com.au/asic** under ASIC Information for Companies.

Employer/Sub-Contractor Requirement


Names of Employee/s seeking to hold an ASIC

 Operational Need of applicants to work in Legislated Security Areas either Landside or Airside Security Zones.

Failure to issue this letter to the Primary Contractor before commencing/ completing an ASIC Application may result in the Primary Contractor rejecting the application. An application cannot be approved without this letter being attached by the Primary Contractor during the approval process.

ASIC Application

When the employer has received confirmation that the company is registered online, the ASIC applicant can proceed with the application process. ASIC Applicants will need to register to use ASIC Online prior to being able to commence an application.



Primary Contractor Approval


The Primary Contractor will be the first level approver within ASIC Online for all Sub-Contractor Applications. The Primary Contractor will need to complete the following actions to progress an ASIC application to the next level. Once all of the steps below are completed, the application can be approved and progress.

Review the application to ensure all details are accurate

Confirm attached identification is valid and upload documents are of good quality

Complete Approvals section of application such as operational need, ensuring that the letter contains the name of the applicant
