#### Indication

The oral treatment for fast acting knockdown of adult fleas on cats and doos. Net Contents: 2 tablets, (6 tablets)

## **Directions for Use**

### Side Effects

For the first hours after administration, the pet may scratch and groom more than normal. In rare cases in cats and dogs. transient signs of hyperactivity and panting may be observed, which may include clinical signs of muscle tremor, ataxia, and hypersalivation. These adverse events are usually transient in nature. Please monitor the animal closely and seek veterinary advice as necessary if signs persist.

#### **Dosage and Administration**

CAPSTAR Tablets can be administered to kittens and puppies from four weeks of age.

Administer one tablet on any day when fleas are evident on your pet. Repeat on any subsequent day when fleas are again evident on your pet. Flea detection can be achieved by examining the skin for signs of flea activity by parting the pet's coat.

CAPSTAR Tablets can be dosed directly into the mouth, or can be given mixed in a small portion of your pet's favourite food. Cats generally prefer a fish-based food like tuna or anchovies.

#### **Dose Instructions:**

Size of dog or cat treated	Dose (tablets)
0.5 to 11 kg	1 small (11.4 mg NITENPYRAM) tablet on any day when fleas are evident on your pet.
11.1 – 57 kg	1 large (57 mg NITENPYRAM) tablet on any day when fleas are evident on your pet.
Over 57.1 kg	1 large (57 mg NITENPYRAM) tablet plus 1 small (11.4 mg NITENPYRAM) tablet for every 11 kg over 57 kg, to be administered on any day when fleas are evident on your pet.

There are no known contra-indications to the use of this product.

#### General Directions **Integrated Flea Control**

CAPSTAR Tablets are an easy-to-use oral treatment for fast acting knockdown of adult fleas on cats and dogs. CAPSTAR Tablets start working within 30 minutes of dosing. Effective long-term flea control demands an integrated approach. This means breaking the flea breeding cycle by using products, such as PROGRAM<sup>™</sup> Tablets (AUS/NZ) or SENTINEL SPECTRUM™ (Australia only) or PROGRAM™

Oral Suspension (Australia only), or PROGRAM<sup>™</sup> 40 and 80 Injectable for Cats (Australia only), alongside CAPSTAR Tablets. Products containing an insect development inhibitor, such as lufenuron, will prevent the development of immature stages of the flea's life cycle.

Regular washing of animal bedding and vacuuming carpets will also help control fleas in the pet's environment. CAPSTAR Tablets should be used when fleas are found on vour pet.
